The agreement includes strict performance minimums, including a Year 1 contracted pipeline target of \$10 million USD and initial deployments in at least two African countries, with continuous revenue growth required in subsequent years to maintain exclusivity.

This landmark deal builds directly on the momentum of Global e·dentity™'s ongoing Cooperative Research and Development Agreement (CRADA No. DHS_25-TSA-014) with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and Transportation Security Administration, where the same mobile AI biometric platform is being evaluated for U.S. airport security modernization.
